

INDIANA & COUNTY TAX WITHHOLDING TABLE

(To figure Indiana State and County Tax amount use the Constant Deduction Table Below)

Exemptions	BiWeekly	Monthly
1	\$ 38.46	\$ 83.33
2	\$ 76.92	\$ 166.67
3	\$ 115.38	\$ 250.00
4	\$ 153.85	\$ 333.33
5	\$ 192.31	\$ 416.67
6	\$ 230.77	\$ 500.00
7	\$ 269.23	\$ 583.33
8	\$ 307.69	\$ 666.67
9	\$ 346.15	\$ 750.00
10	\$ 384.62	\$ 833.33

The example below shows how to use the Constant Table to determine tax withholding.

EXAMPLE:

An employee with a biweekly adjusted gross wage of \$560.00 claims two (2) allowances and is living and working in Tippecanoe County.

Adjusted Gross Wage	\$ 560.00
Less: Deduction from Table	<u>\$ (76.92)</u>
Taxable Wage	\$ 483.08
State Tax Withheld (\$483.08 x .034)	\$ 16.42
Tippecanoe County Tax Withheld (\$483.08 x .01)	\$ 4.83

INDIANA STATE AND TIPPECANOE COUNTY TAX RATES

- 1) State tax withholding rate = 3.4% (.034) of adjusted gross wages.
- 2) **Tippecanoe County tax withholding rate = 1.00% (.01) of adjusted gross wages
